**Finding a place to call home isn't always easy.** But since 1896, Volunteers of America has helped thousands of seniors live in safety, comfort, and dignity. Today, we are one of America's largest nonprofit providers of quality, affordable senior housing.

**In Northern New England,** we have 11 Senior Housing programs with a total of 432 one and two bedroom apartments in Maine and Loudon, New Hampshire. We build our communities in towns where the cost of living often outpaces seniors' incomes. This also helps seniors continue to live in a familiar area near friends, shopping, physicians, church and other important connections.



**Our on site Resident Service Coordinators** help residents connect with the services they need, so they can stay independent as long as possible. This includes assistance with Medicare and Social Security benefits, food stamp and heating assistance programs, classes and workshops, community meals and much more.

**Our communities offer** apartments with full kitchens, handicap accessible elevators, community rooms, laundry rooms, TV lounges, computer labs, social and educational activities and 24-hour emergency on-call services. Income limits do apply.
